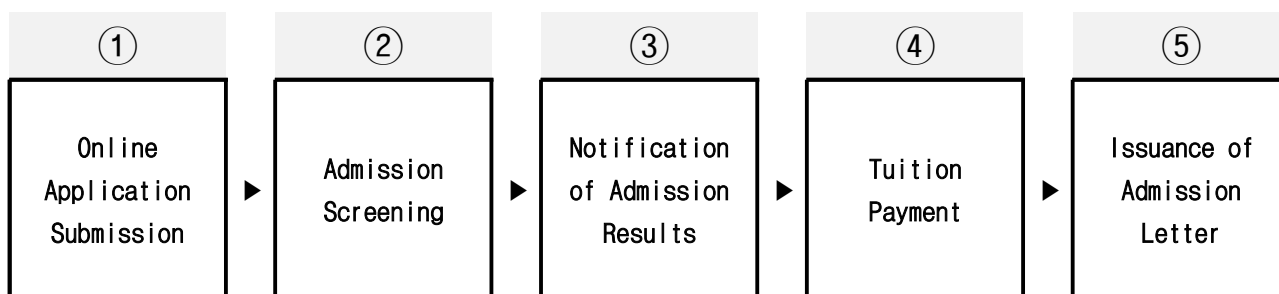
— Important Notes —

3. Documents written in languages other than Korean or English must be accompanied by Korean or English translations.
4. If any modifications are required after submitting the online application, use the 'Edit Application' button on the application page.
5. Applicants residing in Korea must enter their alien registration number and visa type when applying online.
6. Admission certificate will only be issued after tuition payment and submission of academic certification documents.
7. Proof of financial resources:
  - submit later for overseas applicants;
  - required in August for domestic D-visa holders.
