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About NCHU

NCHU established in 1919 as an Advanced Academy of Agronomy and Forestry, NCHU has developed into a comprehensive national university in Taiwan. The university consists of eight colleges, seven research centers, four experimental forest stations, a veterinary hospital, and two agricultural and husbandry experimental farms.

Benefits

- 1 Tuition waiver (mandatory insurance fee is NOT covered, which is around NT\$500/US\$17 per month)
- 2 Monthly stipend from NT\$3,000 - 6,000 (US\$100 - 200) per month will be offered upon availability and qualification of students.

【Note】 Benefits only apply to the nominees that fall within the agreed quota of the partner university agreement.

Nomination Deadline

Student who apply for fall semester (Sep to Jan):

April 5 (of the same year)

Student who apply for spring semester (Feb to June):

October 10 (of the previous year)

Applicant must have an official nomination from home institution to be eligible for academic exchange program application at NCHU.

Application

Student who apply fall semester (Sep to Jan):

April 10 - April 25 (of the same year)

Student who apply spring semester (Feb to June):

October 15 - October 31 (of the previous year)

Nominated Students:

After confirming the nomination by partner institutions, we will provide online application ID and password to nominated students by April 10 and October 15 for Fall and Spring semesters, respectively. Please complete online application at Office of International Affairs at NCHU by this deadline.

Required Documents

- 1.Application form
- 2.Official certificate of student status (must be Chinese or English copy)
- 3.Official academic transcripts (must be Chinese or English copy)
- 4.Two letters of recommendation
- 5.Plan of study (written in Chinese or English)
- 6.Biography (300 to 500 words, written in Chinese or English)
- 7.Certificate of proficiency in Chinese/English (optional)
- 8.Supplementary materials (optional)

Academic Information

Course Registration

Home→for-student→student-at-NCHU→incoming-exchange-student→academics-information

1 credit at NCHU = 1 hour*18 weeks

1 credit ≡ 2 ECTS

PAX students are required to register for at least 6 credits with 1 course in hosting department/institute. The students may also choose courses available in the hosting college to meet this requirement. If students wish to take courses taught in Chinese, they must show Chinese proficiency and/or get approval from the course instructor.

Application Procedure

Home→for-students→study-at-NCHU→incoming-exchange-student

Step 1

Go through the nomination process of the home institution. Partner institution needs to fill out online nomination form before deadline.

Step 2

Nominated students must upload all required documents to application website before deadline.

Step 3

Application will be reviewed, and final decision will be made by the University Review Committee. Results will be announced by the end of June and beginning of December for Fall and Spring semesters, respectively.

Step 4

Official admission package will be sent to program coordinator of partner institutions.

Step 5

Admitted students need to confirm admission and provide arrival information online if admission is accepted.
