– IMPORTANT NOTICE –

1. Applicants must submit their application within the designated application period.
2. Some prospective applicants have been misled by inaccurate information about studying at Kunsan National University. Contact inter_adm@kunsan.ac.kr for accurate information.
3. Kunsan National University **does not** operate a preliminary admission system.
4. Since 2021, some departments may conduct interviews by phone, email, or Zoom in addition to document screening. Provide accurate emails and phone numbers in the application.
5. Documents in languages other than Korean or English must provide with translated copies.
6. If corrections are required, use **Edit Application feature** instead of creating new application. Duplicate submissions will be deleted except the most recent submission.
7. Unless this guideline indicates its possibility of transfer, confirm with the department **in advance** whether transfer admission is permitted.
8. Indicate whether you wish to stay in On-Campus Housing, and enroll Korean language program.
 - ※ Cancellations penalty of **200,000 KRW** will be charged if a dormitory application is canceled after arrival in Korea.
9. Applicants who reside in Korea must provide their ARC number and visa type.
10. Certificate of Admission issued after payment of first-semester tuition and submission of verification documents of your academic history (Apostille, embassy legalization or CHSI/CDGDC)
 - ※ Non-Chinese applicants must present its original on arrival required by Ministry of Justice guidelines
11. Student who obtain less TOPIK level 4 must enroll Korean language courses after admission.

13. Undergraduate students are not permitted to take a leave of absence during their first semester. (In accordance with Article 48 of the Academic Regulations of Kunsan National University)

- **Apostille Conformation:** If the institution is located in a member state that recognizes Apostille Verification, apostille documents may be attached. (Please make sure if your institution are located in countries which member of Apostille)
- **Chinese Ministry of Education's Verification:** Documents submitted by the graduates from the institutions in China must be accompanied by verification issued at the websites: <http://www.chsi.com.cn>
- If any supplementary documents are required, it can be requested by KSNU to the applicant submit them.
- Applicant who has completed Korean language course in Korea should submit **original graduation certificate** with its official verification.
- **Expected graduates should submit the diploma and its official verification documents at latest until Aug. 14(Fri), 2026 (In failure of it, the admission can be canceled)**

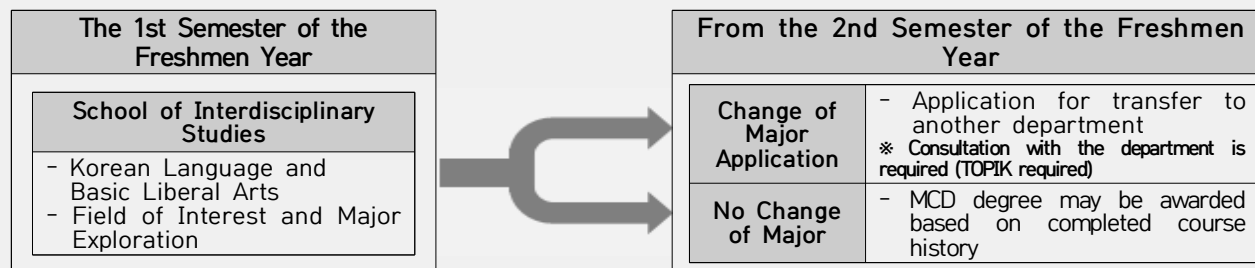

□ Graduation Requirements

- Within one year of admission, if you cannot get TOPIK LV.4 (LV.3 for entertainment and sports major), you only take *Korean classes next semester. You cannot take major classes.
 - * Korean class(you can get the credits) or Korean language program (progress at IALE)
- If you cannot get your credits for graduation because of Korean classes, you need to extend your education period (we do not support your tuition fee)

5 Admission Screening

- (1) The Institute of Int'l Affairs & Language Education will evaluate applicants' eligibility (qualified / disqualified):
 - Verification of nationality citizenship.
 - Verification of education histories, academic credentials and authenticity of submitted documents.
 - Confirmation of whether applicants meet the recommended admission requirements of freshman transfer admission.
 - Verification of any other factors that does not meet the eligibility.
- (2) The respective department will conduct a comprehensive evaluation based on the following criteria and make the admission decision.
 - ① Document-based evaluation:
 - Review of academic records and academic performance at the most recent institution.
 - Verification of Korean language proficiency (or other foreign language proficiency) as specified by the department's requirement.
 - Comprehensive assessment of the applicant's academic ability based on academic records, study plan, and other relevant materials
 - ② Departments conducting interviews:
 - The department may conduct interviews (via telephone or video conference)
 - Applicants will be notified in advance of the interview schedule and method.
 - Interview evaluation will be conducted in accordance with departmental regulations.

* If an applicant fails to attend the interview due to reasons such as incorrect contact information or failure to check notifications, despite prior notice from the department, the applicant will be disqualified. Responsibility for such cases lies solely with the applicant.
- (3) Institute of Int'l Affairs & Language Education will collect result of decision by respective departments and will form admission committee for final admission decision.

- Levels: Basic (1, 2), Intermediate (1, 2), Advanced (1, 2)
- Grade Evaluation portions are following: Mid-term exam (40%), final exam (40%), attendance (10%), homework (10%)
- Mock-TOPIK test will be held at the end of every session
- A certificate of completion will be issued to students who achieve a cumulative average score of 60 points or above , and maintain attendance rate of 80 % or above.
